2024 Andy Wilson Memorial Autotest /PCA Supplementary Regulations

A round of the 2024 RALLYSCORE SAMSC Scottish Autotest Championship ALL PROCEEDS FROM THE EVENT WILL BE DONATED TO THE **BRITTISH HEART FOUNDATION**

1. Glenrothes Motor Sport Club Ltd will organise a Clubman status Autotest / All Forward Autotest / All Forward PCA on Sunday 09th June 2024 at Crail Airfield, Fife, KY10 3XL (MR 59/620085) The Clubman Autotest will feature more technical tests and only this event will count towards the Andy Wilson Memorial Autotest Trophy, all of the events will count towards the 2024 Championship.

The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, the Motorsport UK COVID-19 Guidance for Events and the current Local Authority COVID-19 Guidelines, these supplementary regulations, and any written instructions the organising club may issue.

- 3. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, registered contenders of the championships listed in SR 5, and members of the following invited clubs -
 - Scottish MRC Scottish Sporting CC Dunfermline CC Saltire RC 750 MC (Scotland)
 - Stonehaven & District MC Aberdeen & District MC 63 CC (Elgin) Highland CC Solway CC
 - South of Scotland CC East Ayrshire CC Coltness CC Border Ecosse CC Berwick & District MC

All drivers must hold, and be able to produce upon request, a valid club membership or championship registration card.

Membership of the organising club will be available at £12.00 per adult, £2.00 per junior (16 or under) and must be applied/paid for prior to the day.

A GMSC Club Car will be available to use if you do not want to use your own car, a donation to the Club for the use of the car would be greatly appreciated

4. All drivers must hold, and be able to produce upon request, a valid Competition Licence. From 1st January 2020 all competitors require a minimum of an RS Clubman Licence - this does not affect those who already hold any form of Competition Licence.

The Licence is FREE and it only takes a few minutes to apply online at https://rsclubman.motorsport.org/. Entrants under the age of 18 years are required to complete a paper form as it requires to be signed for by a parent or guardian, these forms can be downloaded from the Motorsport UK website. It would benefit everybody if online application was carried out prior to the event. Paper forms will not be available at the event; online applications only.

7. The Autotest event will consist of 2 Classes as follows -1. Front Wheel Drive Cars. 2. Rear Wheel Drive Cars.

The All Forward Autotest will consist of 2 Classes as follows -

- 3. Front Wheel Drive Cars.
- 4. Rear Wheel Drive Cars.

The All Forward PCA will consist of 2 Classes as follows -P1. Front Wheel Drive Cars. P2. Rear Wheel Drive Cars.

Tyres from Motorsport UK Lists 1b or 1c are not permitted

Autotest

Drivers aged 16, or drivers aged 17+ who do not hold a full RTA Licence, may compete provided The vehicle must be defined as a 'Touring Car'

- Engine Capacity must not exceed 1400 cc
- Forced Induction is not permitted.
- They must not carry a passenger

PCA

Drivers aged 14 years and over who do not have a valid full RTA Licence may compete provided -

The vehicle must be by definition be a 'Touring Car'

The vehicle engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc including forced induction A passenger must be carried who holds a valid, full RTA licence, and be experienced in Autotests / AutoSolos

- Child Safeguarding If a competitor is under 18, the online electronic Entry 9 Form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian, or an appointed representative must be present during the competition. If a parent or quardian will not be present, a representative must be appointed, and must have written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative.
- 10. Awards will be presented.
- 11. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations, and closes finally at 19:00 on Thursday 06th June 2024 all completed COVID-19/, signing-on declarations must be received by this date. The entry fee is £30.00.

All payments must be completed prior to the meeting – no payments will be accepted on the day.

The maximum entry for the meeting is 40 and the minimum is 10, the minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.

Entries will be selected in order of receipt, and then only upon receipt of a completed entry, inc. full payment. Should the maximum entry be reached, a reserve list will be started.Entry fees may be refunded in full should an entry be withdrawn in writing to the Secretary of the Meeting at least 24 hours prior to the start of the event, or should the meeting be cancelled.

13. Provisional results will be published on <u>www.</u> rallyscore.net as soon as possible after the event, within 2 hours of the last car finishing the event (D.26.1.2). Any protests must be lodged as per C.5., and appeals as per C.6, with the Secretary of the Meeting or Clerk(s) of the Course, electronically <u>only</u>, using the contact details in SR 12.

Fees and fines will be processed electronically <u>only</u>. Judicial proceedings will be held either digitally or socially distanced.

14. The event will comprise 4 tests, details of which will be made available electronically with the final instructions, and is the responsibility of the competitor to print out prior to the event. No spares will be available on the day. Each driver will have 3 runs at each test, with the best 2 runs to count.

Ties shall be resolved in favour of the fastest run on Test 1, then the fastest run on Test 2, and so on until the tie is resolved.

To be classified as a finisher, competitors must attempt a minimum of 3 runs at 3 tests.

15. Timing will be by hand held watches or electronic timing equipment -

whichever is available. The starting signal will be a verbal "3,2,1, GO" from

the start marshal, or lights.

The order of attempting tests will be in car number order.

16. Practising will not be allowed.

- 17. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be listed with the final instructions, These will be supplied by the organizers along with the Champion sponsor decals. No spares will be available on the day. Sample time cards will be sent with the final instructions and it is the responsibility of the competitor to print out prior to the event if they wish to use them, there will be no spares. Throughout the competition, the numbers and sponsors decals must be displayed on both sides of the car, preferably upper-foremost in the rear side windows or closest equivalent place.
- 18. Markings and penalties will be as per Table M.7
- 19. All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following,

which are modified (M.6.6.) Pylons may be less than 1 metre high.

20. Any driver involved in an incident must indicate that they are OK by signalling with a "thumbs up" at the front windscreen at the earliest opportunity to the approaching marshal.

If competitors can safely exit the vehicle, they should do so, then stand in a suitable location and respect social distancing
