

## **Bacon and Brakes Grass Autotest Supplementary Regulations**

- 1) Glenrothes Motor Sport Club and Saltire Rally Club will co-promote a Clubman status All Forward Autotest / PCA on Sunday 04/08/24 at Rhynd Cafe, Leuchars, KY16 0DR.
- 2) The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, the Motorsport UK COVID Guidance for events and the current Local Authority COVID Guidelines, these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions the organising Clubs may issue.
- 3) Motorsport UK Permit No's – All Forward Autotest – TBA, All Forward PCA – TBA
- 4) The event is open to members of the organising Clubs and invited members from other Clubs.
- 5) All competitors must hold and be able to produce a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence, the minimum requirement is an RS Clubman licence. If you do not have a licence, the RS Clubman licence is free and is available online at <https://rsclubman.motorsport.org> . Entrants under the age of 18 years are required to complete a paper form as it requires to be signed for by a parent or guardian, these forms can be downloaded from the Motorsport UK website. It would benefit everybody if online application was carried out prior to the event.
- 6) The programme of the event will be –  
09.00 – 10.00 – Scrutineering and signing on  
10.15 – A driver's briefing  
10.30 – First Car starts
- 7) The Autotest will consist of 2 Classes  
1 . Front Wheel Drive  
2. Rear Wheel Drive
- 8) The PCA will consist of 2 Classes  
P1. Front Wheel Drive  
P2. Rear Wheel Drive
- 9) The event will comprise of 4 Tests, details of which will be available on the day of the event. Each competitor will have 2 runs at each test with the best 1 to count, ties will be decided in favour of the fastest run on Test 1.

- 10) Awards will be presented for – Autotest - 1<sup>st</sup> in each class, PCA - 1<sup>st</sup> in each class and an award for Fastest Time of The Day overall.
- 11) The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations, and closes finally at 10.00 on Sunday 04/08/24, the entry fee is £30.00 and all entries must be submitted electronically, via the online entries portal at -

- 13) Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be supplied by the organisers and must be displayed on the driver's side.
- 14) Timing will be by hand held stop watches and the starting signal will be verbal countdown 3,2,1,Go.
- 15) Marking and penalties will be as per Table M.7
- 16) All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following, which are modified – (M6.6.) Pylons may be less than 1 metre high.
- 17) The maximum entry for the event is 40 and the minimum is 10, the minimum for each class is 3, should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.
- 18) The event will be held within the guidelines of the Motorsport UK RACE WITH RESPECT charter, these values are – **Respect, Integrity, Self Control, Fair Play and Good Manners**
